Dear All,

As I was going through the application rules today (as Vittorio also knows) I realized that -as Stefan already says- Vittorio and I cannot be the main applicants. From what I understand, each researcher needs a supervisor who will be the main applicant, and then the budget can include not only fieldwork expenses but also a salary for a post-doc researcher.

I then spoke to Umut, with whom I already made a Marie-Curie application, to make an application with our existing proposal and he agreed.

So I can make two suggestions:

- 1- If as a post-doc my name can appear in two post-doc positions, than Umut can make our environment application (because he is still under pressure to bring external grants to the CMES) and Stefan can make the digital middle east application where Vittorio and I share the workload/salary. I can work on social media in Turkey with pleasure.
- 2- If there can be two post-docs in one application, then I also suggest Vittorio to make a quick research about conflict and forest fires in Iran so that we could include that in our proposal and take Vittorio on board. So that we have equal chances:)
- 3- If this is not something that you prefer/doable, Stefan can make an application and involve Vittorio only. And Umut can make the other application where I can be the researcher. In the application website I saw main applicant, co applicant, and researcher. We can check with Spyros if there can be two researchers (but why not as long as they are 50%).

Let me underline here that I would like to work on the digital middle east project with you, and I am equally enthusiastic about it. So if there are no limitations, I am in for both!

Finally, Stefan, I really appreciate your interest in keeping Vittorio and I here:) Likewise, Umut.

And Vittorio, how great are we that these guys want to keep us so badly ;))))

I'm looking at Crafoord now and, frankly, its not really a bulls-eye setting for us.

Firstly, the main version for applications means one individual applying max 500tkr for stuff that is NOT salaries. And we can't really do anything with that, I guess, unless we frame it as a postdoc for Vittorio/Pinar, see below.

If I understand the second option correctly, which opens up for more funding, there is an opening for applying for post doc funding, in addition to a bunch of other non-salary stuff, but they seem to base it on a notion of that it preferably should relate to an already ongoing project.
