Please accept my apologies for not answering your previous emails. And I am sorry that, because of travels and meetings, I was not able to schedule a meeting with you in Lund

Firstly, I have talked to Petter, and reminded Dalia, about the importance that your intellectual contribution to the project design be acknowledged.
