# Harassment — The hacking

One of the questions that seems to have remained unanswered in the hacking incident was why: why did the hacker target my accuser? The question is puzzling only to those who do not know that I had a relationship with my accuser. **Between 17 April 2017 and 20 March 2018, we have exchanged 42.134 messages with my accuser on Facebook Messenger.** This amounted to 1551 pages (A4) in print (I have printed the messages to present them to the investigator hired by the university). These messages include pictures of our children together on several occasions. Once the hacker got control of my Facebook account — rather easily as I was not using two-factor authentication — he realised that the accuser was my “significant other” for a considerable period of time, and tried to extort money by claiming that I had hired him.

It needs to be noted in this context that:

1. The accuser is not the only person contacted by the hacker. He also tried to extort money from my family, close friends and Erika.
2. I was not even aware that my accounts have been hacked until I was alerted by the accuser. We remained in touch the whole night and I helped her secure her social media accounts.
3. I reported the incident to the police in person the following day. I have also informed Lund University security, and posted a warning on all my social media accounts, advising my friends and followers not to reply to any messages that seemed to have been sent by me (see below).
4. I made an agreement with a private IT company in Stockholm (recommended to me by close friends) which has scanned my computer for all malware and secured my social media accounts. I have presented their report to the investigator during my interview.

## Reporting a hacking incident

It has been a while, so I thought I should remind myself!

In a serious vein, my social media accounts have been hacked temporarily yesterday and someone took control of my Facebook for a couple of hours. In the meantime, he posted on my timeline, saying that I hired him to hack a colleague's account (Pinar Dinc), and publicized his "hacking services". It was an attempt to extort money; so he contacted me through my own messenger and asked for 1000 USD to delete the posts and give my account back. Stupidly, I did so thinking that I can protect my colleague. (Also, confidentially, we found out that my son's cancer is back a third time on Friday; this time he doesn't have much time and no obvious treatments available. So I wasn't myself and sent the money in panic to get rid of the guy).

But in the morning, he started harassing her, asking for 500 USD in return for "conversations" which prove I hired him.

Today, we both went to the police and reported the incident. I informed the police of all the details; gave them my bank account transactions which prove that the payment is made after the posts. And needless to say, no such conversations exist. The police asked me not to interact with the hacker, so he is blocked. But my colleague wishes to get to the bottom of this and is still in contact with him. Apparently, tonight the guy told her that I should get in touch with him.

So I am really in a difficult position here. I am the main victim; I did whatever I could to secure all my accounts and reported everything to the police. But I suspect my colleague believes in this guy. There is nothing he can show but I know - from Turkey and Russia - that good hackers can produce "evidence" (in a high profile case in Turkey, an opposition MP was accused of chatting with terrorists on Twitter. He proved that it was all fabricated but the stain remains).

Any suggestions? I don't think I could do much anyway since I have no clue why this happened and how. One theory that sounded plausible to the police as well is that I attracted attention because I am visible on social media and the story of me raising 250.000 USD for my son's treatment in ten days was big news everywhere, including Swedish newspapers. In fact, we found out about a fake Instagram account on my son's name asking for donations! And the reason my friend is implicated is probably because we were in close contact until about a couple of months ago. If the hacker went through my chats, he would notice that she could be a good target (there are no other women I had a close contact with in the last year or so - THIS BIT IS CONFIDENTIAL; I thought you should be informed about everything).

Anyway, our security officers told me to inform you as well just in case. I am available tomorrow afternoon and Wednesday if you wish to talk to me. Then I am flying off to Barcelona for my son's treatment.

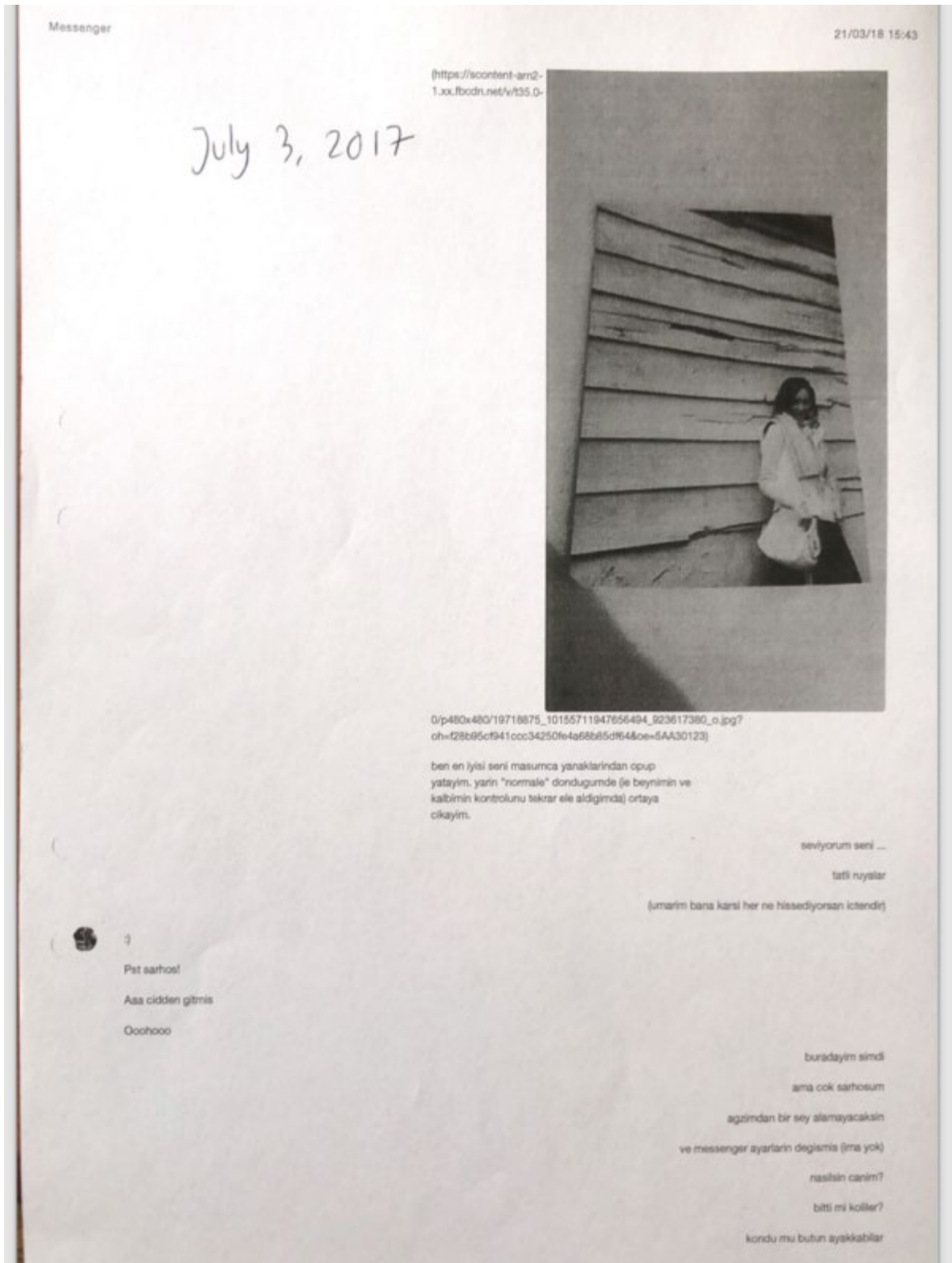

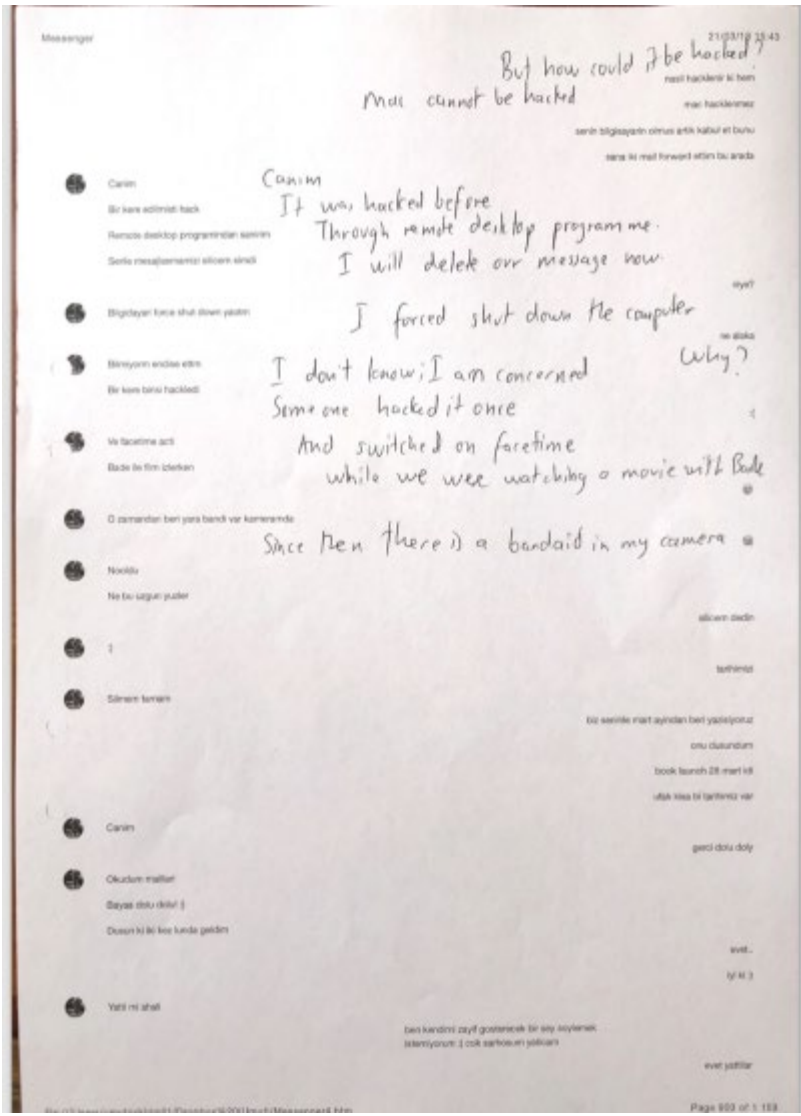

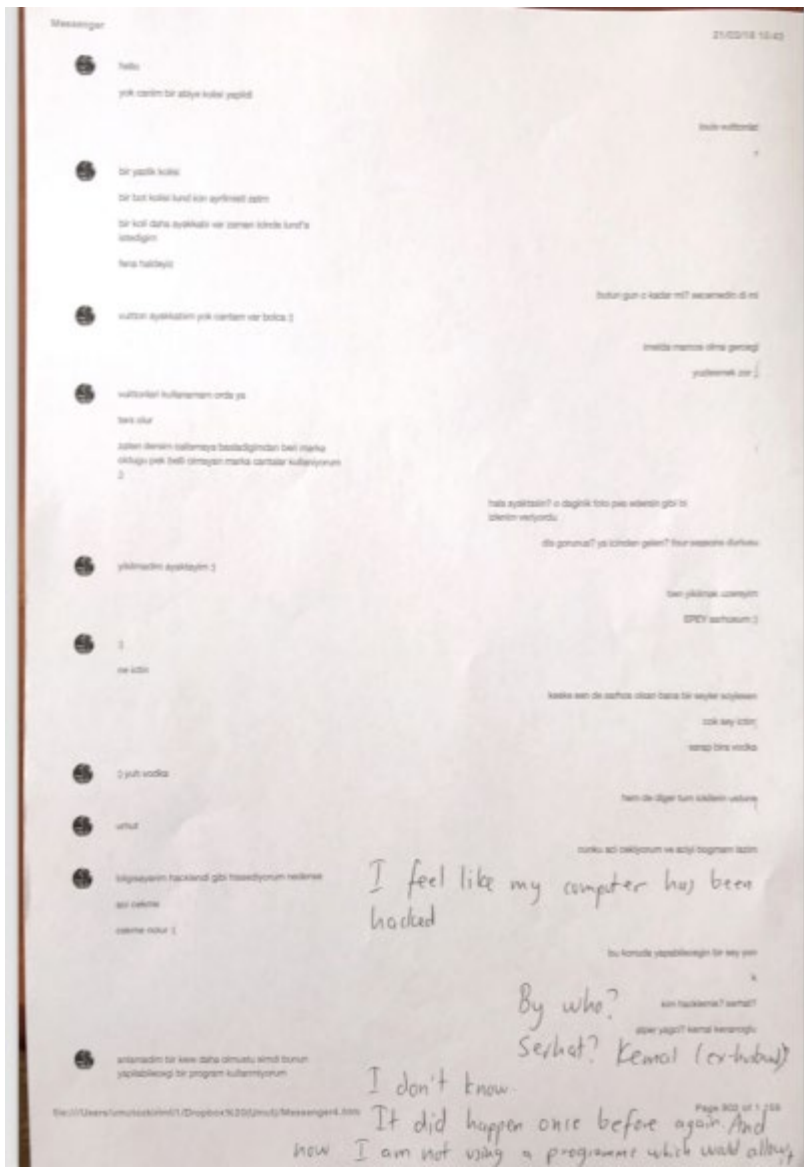
